

THE REPUBLICAN PLATFORM

The 1992 platform of the Republican Party states, "We believe the unborn child has a fundamental individual right to life which cannot be infringed. We therefore reaffirm our support for a human life amendment to the Constitution . . . We oppose using public funds for abortion and will not fund organizations which advocate it . . . We reaffirm our support for the appointment of judges who respect traditional family values and the sanctity of innocent human life."

THE DEMOCRATIC PLATFORM

The 1992 platform of the Democratic Party uses "choice" as a code word for abortion and states: "Democrats stand behind the right of every woman to choose, consistent with Roe v. Wade, regardless of ability to pay, and support a national law to protect that right." The platform also claims that the right to abortion is a "fundamental constitutional liberty."

Absentee ballots

According to Michigan law, you are eligible to vote by absentee ballot if one of the following applies:

- You are 60 years of age or older
- · You will be out of town on election day
- You prefer to vote absentee because of illness, physical disability or religious tenets
- · You are confined to jail awaiting arraignment or trial
- You are an election precinct inspector in a precinct other than the one where you preside

To get an absentee ballot simply call or write to your city, township or village clerk and ask for an absentee voter application. Or, apply in person to the clerk and fill out a standard form. If you want the ballot mailed to you, your application must be received by 2:00 p.m. on the Saturday before an election date. Your vote must reach your local clerk before the polls close on election day at 8:00 p.m.

The Big "R"

In the movies it means Restricted because the show isn't fit for children. For people dedicated to the prolife agenda, the big "R" should stand for Respect.

Respect for whom? At the beginning of our adventures into the political realm of life and death controversies, we had a unique resource person named Pat Nixon (no relation to Richard). The anger emanating from the opposition makes it hard to keep from responding in kind. It certainly did then. It is even more true today. Pat did a great deal of public speaking and debating. She always treated her adversary with consummate courtesy and Respect, and strongly urged her associates to do the same. In fact, she would lose no time in reading the riot act to those of us who fell short. Pat moved south several years ago. We miss her. She was so right.

If we can bring ourselves to Respect our enemies, the rest is easy. We can more easily Respect ourselves and each other when we differ on the road we need to travel as we aim for the "unreachable star." Respect may generate the wisdom we need to see that on whatever path we follow, we are moving, en masse, in the same direction.

The old, the handicapped, the sick in their infirmities and pain, try our patience much of the time. The responsibility to care for one of these may fall to some of us personally, and the manner in which we carry it off will cull **Respect** in them, in ourselves and in those around us. We must devote ever more of our efforts to oppose the enthusiasm for euthanasia that rocks the moorings of our country, and we must be quick to challenge the spurious semantics that accompany it.

The children—struggling for growth and maturity in the wilderness of their own little world—are crying out for Respect. They need always—at whatever age and no matter how aggravating—to be treated as "real people."

Candidate Questionnaire Responses

The following five-question survey was sent to each candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives and the Michigan State Legislature:

- 1. In the near future, the U.S. Supreme Court may vote to overturn its 1973 decision legalizing abortion on demand. In that event, would you <u>SUPPORT</u> legislation permitting states to restore protection to unborn children, except to prevent the death of the mother?
- 2. Rape, incest, and fetal deformity have all been offered as reasons for legislation to deprive innocent unborn children of their civil rights. Would you <u>OPPOSE</u> these exceptions?
- 3. Would you <u>SUPPORT</u> all legislative efforts to continue to prohibit tax-funding of abortion except where necessary to prevent the death of the mother?
- 4. Would you <u>SUPPORT</u> legislation that would ban fetal experimentation and the use of tissue from aborted babies for transplant treatment of diseases?
- 5. Would you <u>OPPOSE</u> legislation if it contained provisions which would cause a person's death who was not imminently dying?

NOTE: Lifespan is not a political organization and does not endorse candidates for election. We have surveyed the candidates as a service to our members. The responses we received are printed without bias, although some had to be edited because of space limitations. The Questionnaires are on file at the Main Office for your perusal. If you need further verification on a candidate's stand on these or other issues, please contact the candidate directly.



Religious Freedom Restoration Act

The "Religious Freedom Restoration Act" (RFRA) (HR 2797, S 2969) is strongly opposed by the National Right to Life Committee, the U. S. Catholic Conference, and a number of other prolife organizations, because organizations such as the ACLU would use the bill as a powerful new legal weapon with which to attack prolife laws in the courts.

The ACLU testified the bill would be used as a basis to argue that abortions "religiously motivated" are immune from laws restricting abortion.

Contrary to earlier predictions, powerful liberal members of Congress, led by Senator Ted Kennedy (D-Mass.) and House Judiciary Committee Chairman Jack Brooks (D-Tx.), have launched a last-minute push to ram this bill through both the House and Senate, and send it to President Bush. The Bush Administration has taken no formal position on the RFRA.

Fetal-Tissue Transplants

The Bush Administration has banned the use of federal funds for transplants of tissue harvested from babies killed by abortion. A bill to reverse that policy (HR 2507) was vetoed by President Bush in June, and the House sustained the veto by a 14-vote margin.

Pro-abortion congressional leaders, led by Sen. Ted Kennedy (D-Mass.) and Rep. Henry Waxman (D-Ca.), are now pushing a second bill (S 2899, HR 5495) to overturn the prolife policy.

The new bill provides that federally funded researchers must first request fetal tissue from a "tissue bank" containing tissue obtained from miscar-

riages and ectopic (tubal) pregnancies, which is being set up by the National Institutes of Health under provisions of a presidential order issued last May 19. But the bill also provides that if a researcher does not within 14 days receive "tissue that the indivudual [researcher] finds appropriate for the purposes of the researcher," then he may use tissue from induced abortions.

So far, prolife senators have blocked S 2899 from reaching the Senate floor. It is hoped that the bill will not come out of the Senate. However, if it does clear Congress, it will be vetoed.

Title 10

The Waxman-Chafee bill (S 323) to overturn the prolife Title 10 regulations has been sent to President Bush, who will veto it no later than September 30. The Senate will vote first on whether to sustain the veto. If the Senate votes to override the veto—which is uncertain—then the House will vote on whether to override. It is believed that the House will sustain the veto.

MICHIGAN NEWS

The Michigan Legislature is in recess until after the November election.

As of press time, no action had been taken on any pending prolife legislation.
