



healthy if they are born around two years apart, rather than only a year apart. When babies are born two years or more apart, mother and baby are healthier. Furthermore, babies do cost money, and so more time between them gives the family budget a chance to recover, too.

WAYS TO PLAN YOUR CHILDREN

Birth control can help you plan your children so that you can have the number of babics you want and have them when you and your husband are well and able to take care of them. Birth control means the use of medically approved methods to postpone pregnancy until you are ready for it. The method your doctor advises for you is harmless and safe.

Planning your children does not only mean being able to wait until you are well enough and able to take care of a baby. Family planning also means being able to have your baby when you do want it. Sometimes couples find that for some reason the wife does not become pregnant. New discoveries in medicine give fresh hope to couples who find they cannot have children when they want them.



YOUR QUESTIONS ANSWERED

In order that you will have a better understanding of the means of family planning here are the answers to the questions which people most often ask:

What is birth control?

It is a safe and simple way to plan for your children and to have them when you want them.

Is it an operation?

It is not an operation of any kind.

Is it an abortion?

Definitely not. An abortion kills the life of a baby after it has begun. It is dangerous to your life and health. It may make you sterile so that when you want a child you cannot have it. Birth control merely postpones the beginning of life.

Is birth control harmful?

Birth control methods which have been approved by leading medical authorities cannot hurt you in any way.



Here's Planned Parenthood's Master Plan on How to Abort Babies if Roe is Overturned

he abortion giant Planned Parenthood launched a three-pronged plan this week to push abortions in the even that the U.S. Supreme Court overturns *Roe v. Wade.* With Justice Brett Kavanaugh now on the high court, abortion activists fear and pro-lifers hope the infamous abortion case could be dismantled by the conservative majority court in the near future.

If *Roe* is overturned, abortions would not immediately become illegal. Instead, states would regain the power to restrict abortions and protect unborn babies. Earlier this summer, abortion activists speculated that at least 22 states likely would ban abortions if *Roe* is overturned.

Planned Parenthood is banking its future on the liberal states that would continue to allow abortion on demand.

In a call with reporters Wednesday [October 10th], Rachel Sussman, Planned Parenthood director of state policy and advocacy, said they plan to focus on at least 10 states where abortion would remain legal and widely available if *Roe* is overturned, The Washington Examiner reports.

It's three-part plan is to, first, expand abortions in states where it likely will remain legal, second, increase political advocacy to push legislation that will keep abortion on demand legal in states across the U.S. and, third, use the liberal media to continue pushing the notion that it's normal to abort an unborn baby.

"We will leverage key states to serve as critical access points, particularly for the growing number of people that need to travel out-of-state," Sussman said.

Here's more from the report:

Sussman said certain states would serve as these access points and mentioned California, Oregon, Illinois, and Rhode Island as potential for network hubs.

A summary of the plan said California is working to boost access to abortion by providing financial help to women who need to travel a long way for an abortion. But Planned Parenthood declined to say how much these networks would cost or key specifics of what a network will include.

"It's going to definitely be a significant expansion of our work," said Dawn Laguens, executive vice president of Planned Parenthood. "I don't think there is a dollar amount that you can put on that."

Elsewhere, Planned Parenthood wants to expand the telemedicine services that it offers to patients,



which it right now offers in 14 states. But it did not lay out a specific goal on how many states it hopes to expand into.

Telemedicine refers to dangerous webcam abortions, where women never see a doctor in person before being given drugs to abort their unborn babies.

The abortion chain said it plans to create a "regional access network" using technology and partner groups to help women get abortions in states where it likely will become illegal.

"For example, California, one of the few states that constitutionally and statutorily protects the right to abortion, Planned Parenthood Affiliates of California is seeking ways to increase access to abortions for people with low incomes, including financial support for women who have to travel long distances, as well as planning how to facilitate telehealth-care and transportation for patients facing obstacles to care," the plan states.

Politically, the abortion giant also plans to expand its lobbying efforts. It wants at least ten key states, including California, Illinois, Maine, Rhode Island, Oregon, Hawaii and Washington, to be an "ironclad network" where abortion on demand will remain legal and easily accessible.

Culturally, Planned Parenthood said it will continue using Hollywood, the music and fashion industry and other outlets to help normalize abortion.

"We'll be enhancing our efforts to destigmatize abortion in the media and across popular culture - including working with the music, fashion, movie, and television industries, and announcing additional public awareness campaigns in the coming months," according to the plan.

Planned Parenthood is the largest abortion business in America, aborting approximately 320,000 unborn babies each year. Its most recent annual report showed a record income of \$1.46 billion, with about half a billion dollars coming from taxpayers.

47 Years of Abortion

"Abortion doula" celebrates being at the side of 2,000 women who have aborted

Editor: If you Google "doula", the following definition is given: "a woman who is trained to assist another woman during child-birth & who may provide support to the family after the baby is born." Just another way the pro-aborts warp the joy of childbirth.

ery recently a story appeared online, talking about this one woman who had undergone an enormous number of abortions. It received a lot of attention until a few people took the time to take a closer look and saw that the source tells you at the bottom that the site is satiric. It was all a kind of sick "joke."

To be honest that is the first thing I thought of when I read a BBC story headlined, "I've been an 'abortion doula' 2,000 times." 2,000?

A quick explanation for or those who may not know what an "abortion doula" is.

It's women who counsel/console/comfort/transport mothers who are aborting their children. Like everything abortion touches, the work of an abortion doula corrupts what a birth doula traditionally does: assist a woman during childbirth.

Back to the BBC's Kirstie Brewer and her story about Vicki Bloom. Turns out since she joined the non-profit Doula Project in New York in 2010, Bloom "has been in the room for more than 2,000 [abortion] procedures."

The whole point (as you would guess going in) of the story is to "normalize" what Bloom does, to make a direct equivalency between what she is assisting and what a birth doula does. And, naturally, to tell women that aborting their child is best for everyone (with the possible exception of the about-to-be dead child).

"I had thought that would feel weird while they were terminating a pregnancy, but actually it makes a lot of sense," says the 50-year-old doula and former food scientist.


"Making sure they can take the best care of the kids they have factors into a lot of people's choice to have an abortion, so their kids may be on their mind.

"I also feel like some people may want to talk about how they take care of their kids to get reassurance that they are a good parent and a good person."

So, if you off your unborn child, you're "a good parent" and "a good person" if you tell yourself this allows you to be a better mother to the kids who've safely made it down

the birth canal. Who knew?

There are some differences,
Brewer explains.
The abortion doula is not around as long as a birth doula.
Something (unspoken) about



it taking less time to kill a baby than deliver her.

What else? "Witnessing," in Bloom's words.

"I will stand up by their head and be looking into that person's eyes, ready for whatever they need, while the doctor is doing the procedure," she says. "Even in clinics where staff are amazing, having someone in that dedicated role can be so valuable."

For later-stage abortions, which require women to go under general anesthetic, Doula Project volunteers will offer to be there not just before, but also while the woman is unconscious.

"Witnessing is a big part of what doulas do," says Bloom. "Some people find it a great comfort to know someone they know, and who they connected with, will be there during the procedure, even if they're asleep."

I was going to comment at length on this but suffice it to say that it is a strange way to "witness" — to stand by while a large baby is either poisoned, be induced and then not cared for, or carved into pieces.

It's a remarkable piece, but all the stories I have read about "abortion doulas" are remarkable. As I once observed, the core message is a kind of lethal solidarity where the abortion doula learns to master the "list of neutral phrases and topics" to use while the woman takes her child's life.

Naturally the real moral of these kinds of stories (but not even alluded to in Brewer's all-smiles account) is that if the abortion doula has any moral, ethical, or spiritual hurtles, she leaves them in the dust.

She has become a kind of born-again true believer in death who will lift up the spirits of the aborting woman and offer the woman her own brand of secular dispensation.

treated by non-medical personnel in a clinic that was filthy. It shows how the press, through omission, had covered up the story - hiding the truth from the public. It shows the darkest side of abortion – it's all a lie.

The whole pro-abortion movement was predicated on lies. Norma McCorvey (Roe) in *Roe v Wade*, said she was raped and needed an abortion - she was never raped, and she never had an abortion. Sandra Cano who was Doe in *Doe v Bolton* went to Atlanta Legal Aid to ask for help in getting a divorce and unbeknownst to her they used her name to proceed with a case for abortion rights. She never


asked this agency for counseling on how to get an abortion.

Dr. Nathanson was a founder of NARAL (National Association to Repeal Abortion Laws) and an abortionist who admits to performing 60,000 abortions in his clinic. In his book, "Aborting America", he described how they deviously put out lies to the press and manipulated the abortion debate in favor of abortion. From an address delivered by Dr. Nathanson to the Winnipeg League for Life on April 25, 1981, he said, "We fed the public a line of deceit, dishonesty, a fabrication of statistics and figures. We succeeded [in breaking down the laws limiting abortions] because the time was right, and the media cooperated. We sensationalized the effects of illegal abortions, and fabricated polls which indicated that 85 percent of the public favored unrestricted abortion, when we know it was only 5 percent. We unashamedly lied, and yet our statements were quoted [by the media] as though they had written the law."

The lies continue. People are not doing abortions to help women, they are doing abortions for financial reasons and to rid society of those they look upon as deplorables. If you don't believe me, go see Gosnell. It is a factual depiction of the trial of Kermit Gosnell. It was because of a detective who cared enough about a dead woman whose death was never reported to authorities, to find out the truth. It was about dead infants left in bags with no thoughts of respect for their remains - many were killed after birth. I encourage everyone to see the movie and see the truth. Discuss it with family and friends and invite them to see it with you (it is PG13). Maybe, just maybe we can change some hearts and minds to the evil of the abortion procedure. Maybe, just maybe, we can dis-

pel the idea that abortion is safe, clean, and helps women. It will be seen by the general public as what it is - a lie. Abortion not only ends the life of a human person but also hurts many, many, women. That is the truth!


