Legislative Update

House Democrats Block Bill to Stop Infanticide For 17th Time, Refuse Care for Aborted Babies Born Alive

n Wednesday, two weeks after Senate Democrats voted to block a bill to stop infanticide, House Democrats blocked a request by Republicans to vote on a similar bill to require medical care and treatment for babies who survive abortions.

This is the 19th time Congressional Democrats thwarted an attempt by Republicans to vote on a bill that would provide medical care and treatment for babies who provide survived failed abortions - 17 times in the House and twice in the

Rep. Brad Wenstrup (R-OH) offered the unanimous consent request to allow a vote on the anti-infanticide bill but Democrats, as shown below, ruled it out of order. After Democrats denied Johnson's request to vote on the bill he criticized them for failing to allow a vote. As Democrats have done on six occasions, the pro-life Congressman's mic was ultimately cut off as he attempted to speak further on the legislation.

After Democrats blocked the vote, Congressman Wenstrup said, "As a doctor, I strongly believe that every patient, especially these infants born alive, should be given appropriate medical care. This should not even be a question. It's our duty, as Members of Congress, to defend the God

-given right to life for every baby in this situation. And it's our duty as compassionate human beings to ensure that these uniquely vulnerable babies receive the care that they deserve."

If the Democrats continue to block consideration of H.R. 962, after 30 legislative

days, Republican Whip Steve Scalise (R-LA) and Rep. Wagner plan to file a motion to discharge the resolution from the Rules Committee.

Leading pro-life members of Congress held a press conference today to discuss their plan for how to try to get around Nancy Pelosi and House Democrats who are blocking a bill to stop infanticide.

House Republicans are working to get a vote on legislation that would protect babies born alive after abortion. They are moving forward with a discharge petition. Since Democrats have the majority in the House — the only way pro-life lawmakers can bring a bill to the floor is to demand a discharge petition and getting a majority of the members of Congress to sign it.

Rep. Cathy McMorris Rodgers, a leading House member, discussed that in a recent interview with the Daily Signal.

"It's just heartbreaking. I was disheartened by the vote, 44 senators that voted against legislation that

would protect babies who were born alive, babies that had survived an abortion, were outside the womb, and yet they were not willing to bring in the insurer under law that they would bring in the doctor's care," she said. "In years past, this is passed with unanimous consent in the Senate. So it really exposed the extreme position that the left is taking right now, that Democrats are saying they reject legislation to protect babies born alive."

"In the House, we are moving forward with a discharge petition. As you know, the Democrats have the majority in the House. One way that we can bring a bill to the floor is to demand a discharge petition," she added. "You have to get 218 people to sign a discharge petition, and then you can bypass Speaker Nancy Pelosi and bring the bill directly to the floor. We're working actively on that right now."

Republicans would need all GOP members to sign the petition, along with 21 Democrats. Rodgers said she hoped polling data showing Americans strongly oppose infanticide would help change members' minds.

The blocking of a vote on a bill to stop infanticide come even as national polling shows Americans — including people who are "pro-choice" on abortion — oppose abortion up to birth and infanticide. And doctors indicate abortions are never needed to protect a woman's health and women admit having abortions on healthy babies.

And a new poll finds a massive 17 percent shift in the pro-life direction after Democrats have pushed abortions up to birth and infanticide nationally.

H.R. 962, introduced by Rep. Ann Wagner (R-MO), ensures that a baby born alive after a failed or attempted abortion receives the same medical care as any other newborn. It would also penalize doctors who allow such infants to die or who intentionally kill a newborn following a failed abortion.

Every single Democrat in the Senate who is running for president voted against a bill that would stop infanticide and provide medical care and treatment for babies who are born alive after botched abortions. That includes Bernie Sanders, Kamala Harris, Cory Booker, Elizabeth Warren, Kirsten Gillibrand, and Amy Klobuchar.

While they all voted to support infanticide, President Trump spoke out against infanticide in two tweets saying that it's nothing short of "executing" babies to let them die after failed abortions.







FDA & the Abortion Pill

The FDA has issued a letter telling her businesses AidAccess and Rablon to cease and desist doing so, due to the dangers posed by the drug to the women who use it.

FDA Clamps Down on Sale of Unapproved Mail-Order Abortion Pills

s part of a wide-reaching crackdown on the online sale of illegal drugs, the US Food and Drug Administration has warned several online providers of abortion-inducing medications to stop the sale of unapproved abortion pills.

The FDA sent last week a letter to Rablon, an online pharmacy network, and Aid Access, requesting they immediately desist selling unapproved versions of the abortion drugs mifepristone and misoprostol online.

According to the FDA warning letter, the "sale of misbranded and unapproved new drugs poses an inherent risk to consumers who purchase those products."

"Drugs that have circumvented regulatory safeguards may be contaminated; counterfeit, contain varying amounts of active ingredients, or contain different ingredients altogether," the letter states.

Mifepristone and misoprostol are two drugs taken together to carry out a medical abortion. They work by inducing miscarriage in pregnancies before 10 weeks.

FDA-approved versions of the drugs have been available to US consumers since 2000, but may only be prescribed by a certified health care provider in a hospital, clinic, or medical office setting. They may not be sold online or in a retail pharmacy.

The health care provider must inform patients about the serious risks associated with use of the medications, and sign a waiver certifying the patient has access to emergency care or a surgical abortion in the case of complication. These requirements are part of an FDA risk mitigation program called REMS, which is used for all higher-risk medications.

The letter to Aid Access stated that the FDA-approved version of mifepristone, called "Mifeprex," is under the REMS program because "the drug carries a risk of serious or even life-threatening adverse effects, including serious and sometimes fatal infections and prolonged heavy bleeding, which may be a sign of incomplete abortion or other complications."

Failure by the websites to correct the violations outlined, the FDA stated, could result in "regulatory action, including seizure or injunction, without further notice."

Aid Access is a website that says it offers abortioninducing drugs to healthy women who are nine weeks pregnant or less.

If women qualify for the pills through online consultations, Aid Access writes them prescriptions for the two drugs. These prescriptions are filled at a pharmacy in India, which mails the drugs to women in the U.S. The service costs \$95, and the website notes that financial aid is available.

Rablon is an online pharmacy network owning at least 87 websites, with sites such as AbortionPillRx.com and AbortPregnancy.com offering mail-order access to mife-pristone and misoprostol.

From the President's Desk

Dear Friends.

There have been a lot of dark days for the pro-life movement since the beginning of 2019. One of the darkest for me was when Governor Ralph Northam, a pediatric neurologist, supported the Virginia "Repeal Act" that would allow legalized abortion up to the time of birth and, if needed and the child was born alive, infanticide if that is what the family wished. How far we have come down the road of accepting the killing of another human person for convenience or emotional reasons. What is happening to the medical profession especially those with the highest degree in medicine or nursing that would allow the killing? Even worse, voted into our body of laws, through legislation, the vehicle which allows the legal killing of another human being without penalty of the law. This law accepted by a medical doctor who happens to be a Governor. It shows that since the Death Peddlers started their crusade in the 60s and 70s, abortion, euthanasia, and now infanticide is now becoming the norm for many of our most trusted institutions and this great country.

Society has become so desensitized by the constant slogan of "Choice" and "Freedom of Choice" that most of the population does not even think through what that choice means. We must continue to persevere; write your letters, call your clergy, challenge a teacher as to the truth, and vote for pro-life citizens who will respect the Judeo-Christian ethic this country was founded on. There will be setbacks along the way, but as long as we don't give up, we will eventually win this war; Choice-death! I coin this new word to describe just what Choice we are fighting. It is not a choice to buy a car, or a choice to run for office, or a choice to eat a carrot. Choice-death means the CHOICE that produces DEATH: Abortion, Euthanasia, and Infanti-
