Hope you are enjoying this fall season. Just wanted to remind you of our new format for the *WCC* (Wayne County Chapter) News. We hope that you will enjoy the new look.

We continually attempt to improve our business so we can keep our Chapter viable to support the *LIFESPAN* Mission. As in all organizations, our members are the lifeline. We've discovered that our membership records are outdated and desperately need current information. Our records have a direct impact on the cost of our mailings, our contacts, and our support. 
