List of Vandalism, Harassment, Threats Targeting Pro-Lifers

Editor's Note: As you will see from this listing, the increase of opposition to being publicly Prolife is becoming increasingly problematic.

At least it is a problem for those who oppose the idea that an unborn child has a right to life and that the mother of that child has the right to hear about all the options available to her before she makes a fatal abortion decision.

Most of these acts of aggression and violence seem to take place on college campuses. Although I do not want to paint with too broad a brush, it would seem that the notion of a college campus being a place where the free expression of ideas is encouraged has become a thing of the past.

Unfortunately it is not just the high schools and colleges where the pro-life message is discouraged, usually illegally. Mainstream media never saw a pro-life event they refused to cover. They also don't report acts of violence or vandalism such as you see below. Social media readily admits that they censor pro life messages, or ban them altogether. Many of us have been placed on Facebook "probation" because the pictures we show of full term beautiful, smiling babies are considered violent content. Silly? Yes – but true. Announcements of upcoming pro-life events are not posted. And when was the last time you saw any accurate coverage of the annual March for Life on NBC, CBS, ABC or the New York Times?

Why all the censorship, hostility and violence? My opinion, and this is an opinion piece, is fear. Fear that the pro-life message is reaching too many people. Fear that our younger generation is rejecting abortion as a solution to a difficult situation. Fear that a lucrative industry might be about to lose its paying customers. And fear that the deliberate killing of a living, sensate human child is just too repellent to continue.

There may also be a concept those perpetuating this violence have not considered. The concept is that the 'forbidden fruit' is very attractive. We all know that if we tell our children, "No, you can't have or do that" it becomes much more desirable to the child and they generally find a way to get what has been forbidden. In this case, trying to suppress the pro-life message with violence and censorship may well backfire

So, praise and courage to all those who put themselves on the line to tell the pro-life story. Your efforts are working. The abortion rate in the United States has fallen from a high of 1.2 million in the year 2000 to 850,000 in 2017. The Guttmacher Institute is reluctant to credit pro-life activities or restrictive abortion laws for the decrease, but did not discount such influences.

We are never asked to do what is easy – only to do what is right. Protecting the lives of babies and their moms is right.

From the President's Desk

Dear Pro-life Friends,

May God give us all the courage, the wisdom, and the fortitude to continue this most vital work of saving the human person.
