### **Governor Whitmer's Reproductive Health Act Explained**

Editor's Note: Votes have consequences. This is one of them.

ansing, MI - The bills making up Governor Gretchen Whitmer's Reproductive Health Act (RHA) were introduced into the Legislature on October 31, and RLM staff have analyzed the changes to Michigan law.

The main bills are identical, SB 622 and HB 5179, and the other bills in the RHA remove sentencing or references to laws it would repeal.

The following are MAJOR CHANGES to state law:

- Repeals Michigan's complete abortion ban and codifies an unlimited health exception in state law.
- Creates an unlimited right to abortion, which could have broad implications. Allows women to sue for damages if she believes that right is being restricted in any way.
- Repeals the partial-birth abortion ban.
- Nullifies the current petition drive to enact a ban on dismemberment abortions (which amends the partial-birth abortion ban).


- Allows abortion facilities to be unregulated and never ben inspected.
- Removes parental consent requirements.
- Removes waiting periods and requirements that abortionists provide women with informed consent and an opportunity to see her ultrasound.
- Removes mandated screening for abortion coercion.
- Opens the door for any medical professional to perform a surgical abortion.
- Stops local governments and schools from regulating abortion in any way, including through zoning laws.

### **IGNITE and EQUIP: My Experience**

My name is Maria Christina Vitale, and this past September I attended the 14th Annual Ignite and Equip Conference with my sister, Monica. (I was also surprised to find out the week before that my other sister also registered, so the three of us were able to attend together!) Even though they have had this conference for 14 years now, this was actually my first time; and there was so much great information that they taught us in just one day that it would take an essay to cover, so here's what I can do for now!:)

One of the two speakers that stood out to me the most was Josh Brahms from Equal Rights Institute. He was very real, very engaging, informative, and challenging. He gave us a lot of tips on how to "be less weird" by helping us engage the pro-choice/abortion side effectively; he reminded us that each person who stands for abortion also has hopes and dreams, a past and a future, feelings, and reasons for their beliefs as well, and that, rather than dehumanize them by seeing them as evil and putting them in a box- get to know them as a person. Befriend them and



have real conversations with them. It is by doing this, by loving them for who they are and providing an open environment for conversation, that you will have the greatest effect.

The second speaker that really stood out to me was the keynote speaker, Jonathan Van Maren from the Canadian Centre for Bio-Ethical Reform. He had an amazing talk titled, "Walking in the Footsteps of Giants" and it was regarding the rich background Christians have in the
