





More than 90 cars joined us!



Abortion: That Which Shall Not Be Named

In the children's series Harry Potter, the character embodying evil was typically called "He Who Shall Not Be Named" by fearful government leaders and citizens rather than Voldemort, his actual name. Voldemort starts the series in a disembodied state, using murder and terror to gradually regain his powers in his own resurrected body. The title character's heroism comes in having the courage to fight back against this unleashed evil and inspire others to as well. Harry's first step was to dare to speak the name Voldemort while others refused to name him out of fear and denial of the uncomfortable reality.

Similarly, fearful government leaders and citizens in our country refuse to mention abortion by name or recognize its evils. On January 22, the Biden Administration pronounced, "In the past four years, reproductive health, including the right to choose, has been under relentless and extreme attack... The Biden-Harris Administration is committed to codifying *Roe v. Wade*..." Notice what word is missing? It is, of course, abortion! Typically, if someone is afraid to mention a word, it is either a dishonest attempt to dodge the truth or one is ashamed with supporting the concept. Both reasons seem to strongly apply to Abortion in this case. An apt historical analogy comes from those who preferred to speak of

"the peculiar institution" rather than mention slavery by name and confront its brutal reality. Speaking of reproductive health, the right to choose, the right to privacy, and protecting women's autonomy are all Orwellian euphemisms meant to hide the truth about abortion and avoid personally defending the indefensible. As pro-lifers, we must be not afraid to oppose the evil of Abortion and our fight begins with telling the truth and calling Abortion by name.

Pennsylvania Lawmaker Who Harassed and Tried to Doxx Pro-Life Teens is Running for Lt. Governor

A Pennsylvania state lawmaker who filmed himself bullying teenage girls as they prayed outside an abortion facility is running for lieutenant governor of the state.

State Rep. Brian Sims, a pro-abortion Democrat, announced his candidacy Monday in a video online. In the video, Sims promised to be a responsible and courageous advocate for Pennsylvanians.

"After 10 years in the state house, I've taken the lessons that my parents taught me and reinforced them in my work as a legislator: to take responsibility, commit to service, be courageous and push for fairness," Sims said in a statement. "I'm ready to take these values to lead the Commonwealth."

But a pro-life leader in the state described Sims as a bully who harassed women and girls because they disagreed with him.

Maria V. Gallagher, legislative director of the Pennsylvania Pro-Life Federation, an affiliate of National Right to Life, told LifeNews: "The representative harassed, intimidated, and tried to doxx teenage girls, along with a senior citizen. His bullying behavior flies in the face of the compassion toward women and girls we want to see from our elected officials in Pennsylvania."

Sims faced national criticism in 2019 after he filmed himself bullying women and girls outside a Planned Parenthood abortion facility in his Philadelphia district. In May of that year, Sims posted a video of himself berating an older pro-life sidewalk counselor outside the abortion facility. A second video that he posted in April 2019 showed him offering \$100 for the identities of three teenage girls, ages 13 and 15, who were praying peacefully outside the abortion facility with their mother.

Facing national criticism, Sims apologized to Planned Parenthood for making abortion activists look bad, but it took him nearly six months to issue an apology – a private one – to the teenage girls and their mother.

Despite a huge protest and national media attention, Pennsylvania Democrat leaders refused to take action against Sims. Bill Patton, a spokesman for Pennsylvania House Democrats, told the Philadelphia Inquirer at the time that they were "satisfied" with Sims' promise that he will not behave that way again.

One of the videos that Sims posted showed part of his interaction with a mother and her teenage daughters who were praying outside the Planned Parenthood on the Thursday before Easter in 2019. In the video, Sims offered



viewers \$100 to identify the girls.

"What we've got here is a bunch of ... pseudo Christian protesters who've been out here shaming young girls for being here. So, here's the deal, I've got \$100 to anybody who will identify these three, and I will donate to Planned Parenthood," Sims said in the video.

The state representative was accused of trying to intimidate the girls through doxxing, a practice where a person's name and contact information are posted publicly online to encourage harassment. Sims' actions may have violated consent and cyberbullying laws, though he never faced charges.

In another video, Sims also appeared to be attempting to doxx another pro-life woman – he called her an "old white lady" – by asking his viewers for her name and address. In the wake of national criticism, Sims released a statement that did not apologize for his behavior. Instead, he chose to attack pro-life advocates even more by claiming they "slur" and "attack" Planned Parenthood patients – without providing any evidence to support his claims.

From the President's Desk

Dear Friends of Life,

Have any of you seen our LIFESPAN Billboards? For the last 2 years, thanks to a very generous family Foundation, we have been able to put up Billboards. We have had a total of 6 Billboards and 15 Posters (large but slightly smaller than a billboard) put up in the Metro Detroit area. Included in our contract is digital advertising corresponding to the message of the Billboards. Our concentration for these Billboards has been in areas that Planned Parenthood and other facilities do abortions. I refer to these facilities as Killing Chambers for unwanted babies. Are those words a little harsh? No, these words speak truth. The truth is the procedure of abortion kills pre-born children. These centers are not a place of healing, but a place that pre-born babies lives end; many mothers of these children are scared forever. Abortion centers will do the abortion procedure - stopping a human life while, he or she, lives in the womb. That human person's life will end before they can take their first breath.

It is with this in mind we placed our Billboards in areas abortionists set up shop. They target poor and mostly black communities (wonder why this is?). The LIFESPAN Billboards bring a positive message to the residences of these communities. We hope that those contemplating an abortion may see one of these messages - stop and think of what they are doing. We hope that the message will encourage discussion within families and among friends.

Our world of communications is so fast, and the information highway is massive; it is hard sometimes to think clearly. We become desensitized to the meaning of so many negative messages or words. Words are heard, and often the meaning of the word is lost due to the high amount of information we receive. The message of abortion is often heard: abortion is the solution to a difficult "problem". Many, especially if you are in crises, never stop to analyze just what abortion means. Getting rid of the "problem" is what is heard - this is what she wants to do. Our message to the community should be one that makes them think what the word means and what will happen when they get rid of the "problem". Getting rid of the "problem" means death to a growing living human person. We hear a lot lately about scientific facts in the media but when it comes to development of the human person, scientific fact is ignored. The scientific fact is human life begins at conception. When the egg of the woman and the sperm of a man unite, the 23 Chromosomes from the mom and 23 Chromosomes from the dad have created a new human person. A person unique in every way. The color of their eyes, their sex, their fingerprints, their unique DNA is set. Just maturation and development will change them, and they will go through the different stages

of their life; a zygote, to embryo, to fetus, to newborn, to adolescent, to young adult, to middle age, to old age -that unique person will end only upon death. In today's world, that death could be in the womb (which is legally protected by government laws on abortion) or at any time during their span of life.

LIFESPAN will continue to educate using different venues; Billboards will be another tool we use to change hearts and minds on abortion. We will work towards bringing back a respect for human life from the womb to the tomb.

May we all have the courage to speak out and continue working on issues that promote love and dignity for the human person
