The Pill that Kills, Delivered to Your Door by Mail

f a vaccine were to kill 24 people and injure 3,000 more, would that vaccine remain available? What about an *abortion drug*?

Despite the recognized danger of the drug Mifeprex (mifepristone), the Biden Administration has lifted safety restrictions on the abortion pill, erasing medicallynecessary precautions that have been in place since FDA approval in 2000.

By tossing out these needed safeguards, the administration and the abortion industry are playing Russian roulette with women's lives, handing them "a loaded gun" in the form of chemical abortion.

According to a statement released by the American Association of Pro-Life Obstetricians and Gynecologists (AAPLOG), which represents approximately 7,000 women's healthcare practitioners, the abortion pill has led to at least 24 deaths and 3,000 injuries, with 500 more women at risk of dying had they not reached emergency medical care in time. Death due to abortion often goes unreported, so it is difficult to determine the true fatality rate of the drug.

Since the FDA stopped collecting data on the "adverse effects" of the drug in 2016, the complication rate could be much higher.

Earlier this month, a 23-year-old Argentinian woman died from a chemical abortion after it was made legal in her country.

Now, in our country, the most pro-abortion President in history jeopardizes the lives of unsuspecting young women as they are misled into believing they can safely abort at home.

No longer will an in-person exam be required to confirm the gestational age of the child or to rule out an ectopic pregnancy or multiple babies or other complicating conditions or to determine if a woman is RH negative and in need of a Rhogam injection.

Rather, the potent drugs can be delivered to a mailbox or pharmacy simply through a tele-health visit with an abortion provider. Planned Parenthood Keystone is already enthusiastically promoting this "service" on their website.

The two-pill abortion procedure is only approved up through 10 weeks, but many young women are frequently uncertain as to how far along they are. The American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology estimates that about 50% of women are wrong about their gestational age when relying on recall of their last cycle, which is why determining the baby's age by ultrasound had been standard practice in the past. Taking the drugs past 10 weeks

significantly increases the chance of complications.

But the abortion drug is dangerous earlier in pregnancy too. AAPLOG notes, "A Finnish study involving nearly 50,000 women who had abortions at 9 weeks or less showed that immediate adverse events were four times more likely with chemical abortion than surgical."

That is why the safety regulations, known as REMs (Risk Evaluation and Mitigation), were enacted in the first place. There is significant risk of hemorrhaging, infection, incomplete abortion, and more that can threaten a young woman's life.

"This requirement is not restrictive-it is protective," states AAPLOG.

And while there is a definite physical risk to women, there is also a tremendous emotional and psychological impact. Young women are left alone to endure hours of severe cramping and bleeding to deliver and dispose of a dead child.

It's hard to understand that anyone could possibly think such trauma is part of "empowering women." Rather than given authentic support at a difficult moment, women are given a pill to kill, one that might kill them as well as their baby.

But under the misleading title of "reproductive justice," that seems like a risk the Biden Administration is willing to take.

Biden-Harris HHS to allow taxpayer-funded research using aborted children, eliminates ethics board

he Biden-Harris administration is walking back the previous administration's policies when it comes to research done using the bodies of children obtained from elective abortions.

According to a statement released Friday, April 16th, "HHS is reversing its 2019 decision that all research applications for NIH grants and contracts proposing the use of human fetal tissue from elective abortions will be reviewed by an Ethics Advisory Board." Scientists and research institutions will be able to apply for federal grants without ethics oversight related to use of the bodies of aborted children.

HHS Secretary Xavier Becerra defended the decision. Politico quotes Becerra as saying, "We believe that we have to do the research it takes to make sure that we are incorporating innovation and getting all of those types of treatments and therapies out there to the American people." Medical groups subscribing to an ends-justify-means philosophy regarding fetal tissue research have pushed for this action since President Biden took office, stressing that "highly worthy, scientifically meritorious research" was being neglected by not being able to use the bodies of aborted children.

In a press release, the National Right to Life slammed the decision that will make it easier to exploit aborted babies with taxpayer funds. "We condemn this sickening decision by the Biden administration," said Carol Tobias, the organization's president.. "Tiny human babies are aborted by abortionists and then exploited to be farmed for their organs and tissue for use in experiments [...] The Biden administration and HHS Secretary Xavier Becerra have dismantled the process of making researchers meet any ethical standards when it comes to harvesting the body parts of aborted children for research."

Archbishop Joseph Naumann, Chairman of the U.S. Catholic Bishops pro-life committee, also condemned the decision. "The bodies of children killed by abortion deserve the same respect as that of any other person," he said, according to CNS. "Our government has no right to treat innocent abortion victims as a commodity that can be scavenged for body parts to be used in research. [...] Researchers have demonstrated that we can do effective scientific research and develop efficacious clinical treatments without harvesting tissue from aborted babies. It is also deeply offensive to millions of Americans for our tax dollars to be used for research that collaborates with an indus-



try built on the taking of innocent lives. I call on the Biden Administration to instead fund research that does not rely upon body parts taken from innocent children killed through abortion."

The use of aborted fetal tissue is not necessary for scientific innovation, and in 2019, the previous administration put ethical safeguards in place in the form of review boards to ensure federal grants were not used for research that used aborted fetal tissue without justification. The board met once, and rejected 13 of the 14 submitted proposals, because the proposals did not utilize ethical alternatives for research, according to SBA List.

Past attempts to shed light on the illegal sale of aborted baby parts for research and other uses have been met with hostility. In 2017, then-Attorney General of California Kamala Harris teamed up with Planned Parenthood to suppress pro-life journalist David Daleiden and CMP's investigation into Planned Parenthood's participation in the trafficking of fetal tissue. Daleiden sued both Harris and then-Attorney General Xavier Becerra, and has been tied up in legal battles since.

Bill Introduced in Michigan House to Ban Targeted Abortions

In the last week of April 2021], a ban on targeted abortions was introduced in the Michigan House. House Bills 4737 & 4738 would ban abortions targeted at babies not just diagnosed with Down syndrome, but any disability, as well as babies targeted for reasons of sex or racial discrimination.

The bills, sponsored by Rep. Julie Calley and Rep. Andrew Fink, would make it a felony punishable by up to two years in prison for the person who knowingly performs a targeted abortion. The bills define disability as any physical or mental disability, and specifically lists several common disabilities for inclusion.

On April 12, the U.S. Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals allowed Ohio's ban on targeted abortions of children with Down syndrome to be enforced while court challenges continue. Michigan is also under the jurisdiction of the Sixth Circuit.

With the legal situation in the Sixth Circuit, this is our highest priority, since a targeted abortion ban would be enforceable now. Because the neighboring Fifth Circuit struck down a similar Indiana law, this is an opportunity for the U.S. Supreme Court to weigh in.

Abortion is used as a tool of discrimination on a horrifying scale. We have heard of situations where parents of women in interracial relationships have attempted to convince or coerce their daughters into getting race-selection abortions. More than 160 million women around the globe are missing because of sex-selection abortions.

Some countries boast of all but eliminating certain disabilities by targeting disabled children in the womb. Most people would be horrified of taking the life of a disabled child a day after birth, and they should be equally horrified by the idea of taking that child's life a day before birth.



Gallup asked a polling question on this in 2018. Only 29% of Americans thought it should be legal to take the life of a child with Down syndrome in the third trimester, and only a minority, 49%, thought it should be legal in the first trimester. Majorities thought abortion should be illegal in the third trimester for mental disabilities or conditions that threaten the life of the child. It's clear *Roe v. Wade* and the current state of abortion law is nowhere close to lining up with the views of the American public.

With continuing advances in care for the disabled and new programs like perinatal hospice, there are better options for society to invest in than causing the death of these little ones. A modern society that prides itself on creating equity can't be a society that allows violently taking the life of a child deemed unworthy of human care because of a physical or mental characteristic

From the President's Desk

My Dear Pro-Life Brothers and Sisters,

Why do women still believe and fall for the lies of the antilife culture? It is because so many of our young women get their information from those who have financial gains from pushing the lie. There are many lies perpetrated by the antilife crowd, too many for one letter. Remember in the 70's and 80's; before an abortion, women were told that what was in the womb was "just a blob of tissue". Then came the fetal ultrasound and women could see their baby sucking their thumb, kicking, doing summersaults, and sleeping. It was not a blob of tissue. The lies are numerous and too many for this article. The one I want to talk about today is a horrendous lie which could and will harm many unsuspecting women who, out of desperation, fall for the lie.

The lie is that mifepristone is SAFE enough to sell over the counter without a doctor's prescription. Mifepristone is a chemical abortion pill also known as RU-486.

This is a powerful drug. It cuts off hormonal support, causing the fetus to die. It then causes the uterus to contract expelling a dead baby.

The Biden/Harris Administration's Federal Drug Administration suspended mifepristone's risk evaluation and mitigation strategy enforcement and made chemical abortion pills available without in-person medical consultation. The lie is that they are helping woman. After reading the following information can you say that this drug really helps women?

Studies have shown Mifepristone:

- 1. Causes more bleeding and/or infection than surgical abortion.
- Often the total content of the uterus is not expelled causing surgical intervention to remove contents of the uterus which may be tissue, parts of the placenta or even parts of the baby.
- 3. The above complications are usually treated I in the ER and the true cause of patient's problems have never been reported.

 Consequently, little data is compiled to show the complications of chemical abortion or even the numbers of abortions by chemical ingestion International studies that have been done show approximately 7% of women end up with surgery after RU-486.
- 4. Studies have shown drugs sold over the internet have serious problems with the content of the pills. These are being shipped in from overseas. The black-market quality of these pills has been found to be inferior and contaminated.
- 5. Lack of monitoring by a medical professional could lead to serious medical problems if the women have an:
 - A. Ectopic pregnancy (if not diagnosed, could cause death to the mother)
 - B. Lack of diagnosing the presence of

the Rh factor in women, could result in complications with future children, if not given the proper therapy -RhoGAM.

So, I ask you again, who is **helping** women? Not the proabortion culture.

Who is **lying** to women? The **pro-abortion** culture.

This includes much of the media, our public schools, the pharmaceutical industry, many in the medical profession and our government leaders. No wonder it is hard for women today to know the truth. It is up to us in the pro-life movement to speak the truth on matters of life and death. It will be hard because there is a lot of money backing pro-death causes. But fight we must. If, within your family and friends, you have young women who may want to use Mifepristone, please educate her on the dangers of this drug because no one else will. The simplest way to educate her is to pull up a site on the internet like WebMD and type in Mifepristone. See for yourself the drug information and adverse reactions of this medication.

Even though you may not feel a young woman you might know would not use this drug, talk to her anyway. Ask her to talk with her friends. As I said, very few in her circle of acquaintances will be aware of this information. It will be her and her friends who could be harmed by this destructive drug.

So much for the Women's Liberation Movement who gave us the so-called freedom to choose. Choose what! The choice to kill their offspring but no choice when it comes to knowing the truth about complications to herself when making other medical decisions. It is another lie when women are NOT told the truth about abortion and safe health care. We have not been liberated. We are being used and degraded again.

WOMEN, let not the abortion industry dictate truth to us. It is our responsibility to gain knowledge, seek out the truth and use common sense when we make our health care decisions. True "women's liberation" will come when the word "right to choose" means more than killing your offspring.

May we all have the courage to be teachers to women who do not know the truth about "choice".
