NIAID Funded Research With Body Parts From Viable, Healthy Babies Killed in Abortions

new investigation by the Daily Wire found that the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID), headed by Anthony Fauci, supported a study at the University of California - San Francisco that used organs from 18 to 23 week aborted babies to study bacterial growth.

The study "Viable bacterial colonization is highly limited in the human intestine in utero" was published in February 2020 in the journal "Nature Medicine."

According to the study, researchers used "donated" intestine, kidneys, spleens and lymph nodes from aborted babies at 18 to 23 weeks gestation. The babies' organs came from the Department of Obstetrics, Gynecology and Reproductive Science at Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital, the study noted.

The babies' organs "were collected by a single operator using sterile tools within 10 minutes of termination procedure and placed into sterile containers" and then "transported in media on ice and processed within 2 hours after collection," according to the study.

The researchers acknowledged several sources of taxpayer funding that they used to conduct their study, including a National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases grant from which the university used \$113,727 since 2017 (Grant No. F31 AI136336), the Daily Wire reports. Other taxpayer-funded grants came from the National Science Foundation and National Institutes of Health.

The group that initially discovered the study, Pro-Life San Francisco, has been urging UCSF to stop its unethical abortion and research practices, according to the report. Earlier this week, Pro-Life San Francisco released documents it received from the university through a public documents request showing how UCSF is harvesting aborted babies' genitalia and other organs for research. Unbeknownst to most Americans, their tax dollars are funding these disturbing, unethical abortion practices. Earlier this summer, David Daleiden, founder of the Center for Medical Progress, told Townhall that [NIAID] also gave \$61 million to the University of Pittsburgh in 2019 for scientific research, and some of that money funded gristly experiments involving aborted baby body parts being attached to mice and rats.

In one study, scientists used scalps from aborted babies between 18 and 20 weeks of pregnancy to create "humanized" mice and rats to study the human immune system. The researchers described it as "full-thickness hu-



man skin."

Along with their article, the researchers published photos of their experiment – horrific images that show tufts of babies' hair growing on the rodents.



I am ready and excited to join the fight for the Right to Life of the Unborn!



When I was made president of my university's chapter of Protect Life MI, we were at the height of the COVID-19 pandemic. Schools were forced completely online, so we didn't have many opportunities for outreach. Although I'd studied apologetics and given talks on how to converse with pro-choicers, I didn't have much hands-on experience myself, having done only two outreaches in an entire year. I wanted to get more experience and practice using the apologetics I'd studied.

I was thankful to Right to Life – LIFESPAN for sponsoring me so I could go and participate in the Life Advocate Intensive training this summer. I was excited and eager to learn more about how and when to use certain arguments, and I was especially excited to have the opportunity to change hearts and minds about abortion. That was the biggest draw to Protect Life for me in the first place; for the first time, I would have the ability to do something about an issue I deeply cared about. Those three days at LAI were exactly what I needed to give me the confidence to do well in outreach.

I was energized for advocating for the unborn and equipped with apologetics skills to engage in fruitful conversation on the street. I felt a sense of comfort knowing that regardless

how it went, any conversation that could get someone to at least consider the reality of abortion would be worthwhile. I was ready for those that disagreed with me; I was not ready for those who didn't have an opinion. I couldn't believe how many people walking by merely shrugged.



To every apathetic person that brushed us off, we challenged their perspectives as they walked by. For every man that said he wasn't entitled to an opinion, we had another on our side gently asking him why. For every person that said, "my body, my choice," we asked where that line ended. We stood firm and handled the flood of people cursing us and our cause, and when we needed encouragement, we turned to each other. As long as there are people unafraid to stand for what's right, we have hope. It's an uphill battle, but it's worth the struggle if it means that even just a few women realize that abortion is never the answer to an unplanned pregnancy.

I am so thankful that Right to Life - LIFESPAN gave me the opportunity to be the voice for the unborn!

The Life Advocate Intensive training was enriching, challenging, and life-giving. We hit the ground running. We certainly had time to meet others, have fun, and build real community, but we truly worked hard! On each day, we did outreach in the downtown area of Grand Rapids where I conversed with a lot of different people. Some pro-life, some pro-choice, and some did not have any opinion at all.

My most memorable conversation was with two friends named Alex and Roman. I politely asked, "What do you guys think about abortion?" They gave an honest response saying that they had not thought about it much at all. They explained that they knew friends and siblings who had an abortion in the past and that it must be okay in certain circumstances because of a woman's tough circumstances. Remembering back to my training I found common-ground by saying, "I totally agree with you that being pregnant and being impoverished must be super hard", then I moved on to make my analogy and question, "Can I give you a scenario? What if the mother had her baby despite financial difficulty for whatever reason. Now that baby is a toddler, a couple years old,

where the mother and the baby are in the same hard circumstances. Does this give us the right to kill the toddler?" They replied no because it's different like one would expect.

I moved on to explain that the Size, Level of Development, Environment, and Dependency could not possibly justify the killing of a human being. They replied that it was hard to say that a fetus was a baby. I addressed the fact that an embryo is unlike any other "clump of cells" one might compare it to because it has the wonderful ability to grow. I definitely could have improved on explaining the biology of the unborn and why the unborn is human. Nonetheless, they listened respectively and tracked with me for what I had to say (which I GREATLY appreciated). Alex said, "Wow. I definitely have to think about this some more. Thank you for being respectful and having a civil conversation - a lot of people nowadays can't have this." I thanked them from the bottom of my heart and sent them on their way. They stopped at the corner with some of the other pro-life advocates for the light. Before they crossed Alex jogged back to me and thanked me once again for talking so respectively and standing for my beliefs.

Hyde Amendment Excluded from Bill

The House of Representatives passed a package of spending bills this week without provisions banning federal fund-

ing for most abortions in the U.S. and abroad, marking the first time in decades that the restrictions have not been included. A provision known as the Hyde Amendment has been included in every package since 1976. The House also excluded the Helms Amendment which has barred U.S. funds from being used for abortions in other countries since Congress passed it in 1973. The result is that your tax dollars can now be used to fund abortions here and abroad. UPDATE: An amendment proposed by James Lankford, Representative from OK, includes the Hyde Amendment's prohibition on Federal funding or abortion on demand. The amendment also includes conscience protections for health care providers and insurance companies. Although the amendment is non-binding, none the less signals the chambers majority support for the prohibitions found in the Hyde Amendment.

What Changed???

In a letter to his constituents in 1984, Mr. Biden said that "those of us who are opposed to abortion should not be compelled to pay for them." And when running for President in 2008, he said he was "still opposed to public funding for abortion."

Amicus Briefs Support Life in Dobbs Case

The *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health* case regarding Mississippi's ban on abortions beyond 15 weeks continues to draw great attention from both pro-life and pro-abortion supporters. Numerous pro-life organizations and leaders have filed amicus curiae, "friend of the court" briefs, with the U.S. Supreme Court to back the State of Mississippi and Mississippi Attorney General Lynn Fitch in arguing the case. Twelve state Governors, 44 U.S. Senators, 184 U.S. Representatives, former Vice President Pence, 79 pro-life woman state legislators, the National March for Life, Susan B. Anthony List, Students for Life of America, Thomas More Society, Center for Medical Progress, and Democrats for Life of America among many others have filed briefs to overturn the evil existing jurisprudence on abortion.


