An Answer to 49 Years of Prayer?

Justice Clarence Thomas has consistently called for the Court to review *Roe* and *Casey* for years. He was largely silent in *Dobbs* arguments, but probably strategically so as Thomas is a sure vote to protect the unborn. Justice Neil Gorsuch is assumed to be a pro-life vote. Justices Thomas, Alito, Gorsuch, and Barrett seem poised to overturn Roe. Justice Kavanaugh seems more likely to vote to overturn *Roe* than not. Justices Sotomayor, Kagan, and Breyer are sure votes to maintain *Roe*. Chief Justice Roberts may seek a middle ground. Two results seem most likely. A 6-3 or 5-4 decision may overturn *Roe* and *Casey* outright. It is also possible that the 3 pro-abortion justices join with Roberts in a compromise ruling that would also need one more vote to maintain a right to abortion while upholding Mississippi's 15-week ban and allowing States significant room to curtail abortions. In 2020, *LIFESPAN* added an official policy on Human Trafficking. According to the U. S.
