As it is Black History Month, *LIFESPAN* would like to reiterate our defense of human dignity in all its forms. The two greatest evils in American history are slavery and abortion. The Radiance Foundation, headed by our April *Be the Change* youth conference speaker Ryan Bomberger, established the End Both campaign which can be found at https://radiancefoundation.org/endboth. The campaign details that 56 million abortions occur annually, killing preborn babies equal to 0.8% of the world's population. In 1860, 25 million people were enslaved worldwide, equal to 1.9% of global population. Today, 27 million people are enslaved, which is 0.4% of global population.
