Michigan Ends Abortion Reporting



The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services released its final reporting of abortion statistics in Michigan for 2023. Due to the Reproductive Health Act championed by Gov. Whitmer and passed in 2023, Michigan law now prohibits state agencies from collecting or compiling **any** abortion statistics. Previously, Michigan tracked statistics such as where abortions were performed, the type of abortion procedure, complications, and the mother's marital status, age, and previous history of abortion. Ending the collection of complications and the facilities with high rates of complications will have a negative impact on women's health. This also means the CDC will no longer be able to include Michigan in its national abortion statistics. Michigan becomes 1 of only 6 states to fail to report on abortions joining California, Maryland, and New Jersey. PAS with No Conscience Protections



The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services report for 2023 was the final reporting of abortion statistics under Michigan law as detailed last week. Abortions rose 3.7% over 2022 with 31,241 preborn lives terminated. It was the highest number of abortions reported since 1994. Chemical abortions accounted for 55% of this total. With Ohio voting in favor of unlimited abortion in 2023, the number of out-of-state abortions in Michigan remained steady at 9% of the total. Preborn human life remains cheap in Michigan.
