Justice Restored for Pro-Life Activists

In his first week in office, President Trump pardoned 23 pro-lifers who were selectively prosecuted with felony violations of the FACE Act and imprisoned over peaceful protests at a time when widespread vandalism and even arson at Pregnancy Help Centers went unsolved by the Department of Justice. The DOJ dropped 3 additional pending cases and announced FACE Act violations will only be charged if approved by the head of the DOJ Civil Rights Division. Also, California agreed to drop all charges filed against David Daleiden and Sandra Merritt of The Center for Medical Progress for publishing undercover videos of Planned Parenthood executives discussing sales of body parts of aborted babies. U.S. Defunds Foreign Abortionists

In his first weeks in office, President Trump reinstated the Mexico City Policy which bans Federal funding for NGOs which finance abortions or involuntary sterilizations in foreign nations. This includes \$100 million provided by the U.S. taxpayers to the International Planned Parenthood Foundation. Trump also withdrew the U.S. from the World Health Organization (WHO). The UN previously passed a non-binding declaration to give the WHO expanded powers in future pandemics including a mandate to promote, "universal access to reproductive health services," the preferred euphemism for abortion in international diplomacy.
