



Pro-Life Legislative Luncheon Recap

LIFESPAN supporters gathered at Laurel Manor on October 19 for our premier annual educational event, the Pro-Life Legislative Luncheon. Attorney Jason Negri offered expert advice on safeguarding yourself and your loved ones with a documented Medical Power of Attorney. A Medical Power of Attorney establishes your desire not to be deprived of food and water when incapacitated and safeguards this by naming a person you trust as the Patient Advocate who will make medical decisions on your behalf rather than defaulting to attending medical personnel. Moving to physician-assisted suicide, Mr. Negri noted that arguments appealing to religion no longer work in American culture. He then proceeded to provide six reasons physician-assisted suicide (PAS) is a bad idea.

#1 *Coercion:* The mere availability of PAS makes it the default solution for some patients and doctors.

#2 *Social Trends:* The current societal trends are tending in favor of PAS. **Those of us in opposition must form coalitions.** Disability rights groups are often very strong advocates for protecting the vulnerable.

#3 Elder Abuse: This is a growing problem in its own right. In Oregon, the state where PAS is most widespread, many patients fill a prescription for PAS pills, but never take them. Two must witness consent to PAS and one witness cannot financially benefit, but **one witness CAN financially benefit from death due to PAS**. Nothing stops a close friend or romantic interest of a beneficiary from serving as the witness who does not financially benefit. Murder will be made perfectly legal under a PAS regime.

#4 Cost Control: PAS will <u>always</u> be the <u>cheapest</u> option available! People will be made to feel they are a burden to society. This cost control bias behind PAS is as clear as day in Canada, even in the VA system.

#5 "*New Standard of Care*": If PAS becomes the new standard of care, why would society continue to spend resources on effective palliative care?

#6 No Conscience Protection: In many cases, PAS provides no exemptions for physicians who conscientiously object to PAS. Michigan's SB 681 does include some conscience protections for doctors, but provides no protections for nurses or pharmacists.

State Rep. James DeSana provided legislative updates fresh from the State Capitol. With the Michigan House of Representatives majority flipping in the General Election last month, Michiganders will be safe from legalized physicianassisted suicide in the new legislature. However, this does not mean devotees of the cult of death in our state will not attempt a ballot proposal in 2026 to override the State Legislature. More urgently it is possible, albeit unlikely, that the lame duck legislature may seek to rush Senate Bill 681 and its companion bills to legalize physician-assisted suicide through before their current majority ends on December 31. If this occurs, Rep.



The ultimate reality show? An unborn child's life is as dramatic as any series you will watch on cable television.

The reality of the hidden life of the unborn child can pop up in the least likely of places.

I happened to be watching a "reality show" known for its contentious female friendships when I was surprised to see one of the leading ladies show up at an obstetrician's office.

They suspected she was pregnant after having suffered the devastation of a miscarriage. She very much wanted a "rainbow baby" to bring hope and healing into her life.

Sure enough, the ob/gyn office confirmed the pregnancy, in all its glory, in the ultrasound image that appeared on the screen. The mother was overcome by emotion at the portrait of personhood before her, very early in the first trimester of pregnancy.

She was also enamored by the heartbeat that was clearly detectable in the preborn baby's first six weeks of life in the womb.

As a viewer, I felt pure joy at this scene – a mother and father seeing their beloved child for the first time. The image was to be the first in the baby's scrapbook.



The development of the child in utero is the ultimate reality show. The heart starts pulsating at a mere 24 days after conception; brain waves can be detected 43 days after the union of egg and sperm.

The life of an unborn child is as dramatic as any series you will watch on cable television. It is intense in its beauty and amazing in its grandeur.

Those who work in the abortion industry and their advocates in Congress and elsewhere are simply denying reality when they fail to acknowledge the humanity of the unborn child. They are also denying science and the basic biological fact that life begins at fertilization.

But in the end, the ultrasound image carries with it a dignity and grace which cannot be denied. Life bursts from the screen with all its possibility and promise.

When it comes to the cause of life, reality is, indeed, on our side.

DeSana reminded it will be vital for constituents to contact Democratic members of the State Senate and State House who are Muslim or have backgrounds in health care in order to communicate reasoned opposition to physician-assisted suicide. This small group of legislators on the fence may ultimately decide a vote brought up on the bills.

To be able to lower ticket prices and make the Pro-Life Legislative Luncheon more accessible in October 2025, we will return to a simple continental breakfast menu and earlier morning start time.
