### November 15-16: *Right to Life – LIFESPAN Why Abortion is preeminent for Christians*

It is in fashion to posit that one can be moral if one is pro-choice but also supports “the poor”. This is a false comparison. The preborn child is the poorest of the poor, possessing nothing and completely dependent on her mother for life itself. The preborn child has no voice to protest when he is dehumanized. The social revolution inherent in Christianity is the core Gospel principle of the inherent dignity of every human person. This certainly includes a great many of the poor and marginalized, but it is also clear that the right to life is the foundation to all other rights. While the violence of wars in Gaza and Ukraine has killed tens of thousands, the violence of abortion kills 60 million around the world every year, including 1 million Americans. Christians are called to confront a legion of injustices but in proximity, scope, and size, it is abortion that sets the tone for the widespread dehumanization of the other in our modern Culture of Death.



### November 22-23: *Right to Life – LIFESPAN*

### *Pacific Justice Institute*

Dr. Dave Peters of the Pacific Justice Institute was legal speaker at the 2025 Pro-Life Legislative Breakfast. Dr. Peters represented 6 pro-lifers who conducted a peaceful protest outside a Sterling Heights abortion mill and were tried and convicted for violating the Federal FACE Act and for Conspiracy under Section 241. Section 241 was passed in the Enforcement Act of 1870 to target Ku Klux Klan terrorism. Section 241 had never before been used on peaceful protesters. By doing so in this case, the Biden Justice Department committed an egregious violation of civil liberties and democratic norms. Before appeals, President Trump issued a pardon in January.
